


Precaution When Upgrading PCS-XG80 from Ver2.03 to Ver2.04

When upgrading the PCS-XG80 with the Ver.204 software, a codec upgrade is followed by a camera upgrade.

Never turn off the power of PCS-XG80 until **upgrading the camera unit is completed**. It takes **about 15 and a half minutes** to complete upgrading the unit (codec and camera) from Ver2.03 to Ver2.04.

Example when upgrading the system from Ver2.03 to Ver2.04 using a Memory Stick.

- 
1. Insert Memory stick containing Ver2.04 software in PCS-XG80 and power on.
Approx. 1 min. and 40 sec.
 2. After the system starts up and the start-up sound sounds, the screen displays on-going messages.
Approx. 6 min. and 30 sec.
 3. At the completion of the codec upgrade, the message "Reboot the system" is displayed
 4. After the system starts up by itself, the camera upgrade starts automatically. The monitor screen turns to pink and the message "Now upgrading. Please wait a while. Be sure not to turn off your system while upgrading." is displayed. (During this period, the communication status LED on the camera blinks.)
Approx. 1 min. and 50 sec.
 5. At the completion of the camera upgrade, the camera unit starts up itself and the start-up sound sounds.
Approx. 5 min. and 40 sec.
- Total amount time**
Approx. 15 min. and 30 sec.
- By this, you can find the system (codec and camera) to be upgraded completely.

Note - It takes about 29 minutes to upgrade the system from Ver1.04 to Ver2.04.
- It takes about 15 and a half minutes to upgrade the system from any of Ver2.00, Ver2.01, or Ver2.02 to Ver2.04.
